# AB InBev reports on the progress of its share buy-back program announced on 31 October 2023

January 8, 2024 – Anheuser-Busch InBev (Euronext: ABI) (NYSE: BUD) (MEXBOL: ANB) (JSE:ANH) ("AB InBev") ("the Company") hereby discloses certain information in relation to its share buy-back program announced on 31 October 2023, in accordance with article 8:4 of the Royal Decree of 29 April 2019 implementing the Belgian Code on Companies and Associations. Under this program, AB InBev has granted a discretionary mandate to an independent financial intermediary to repurchase AB InBev shares for an amount of 1 billion USD<sup>2</sup> during a 12-month period.

Further to the launch of the share buy-back program announced on 31 October 2023, AB InBev reports the purchase of 1,160,995 AB InBev shares in the central order book of Euronext Brussels in the period from 1-Jan-2024 up to and including 5-Jan-2024. The shares were repurchased at an average price of 58.6676 EUR per share for a total consideration of  $\in$  68,112,789.00 EUR.

Since the start of the share buy-back program on 13 November 2023, AB InBev has bought back 7,269,939 shares for a total amount of 418,112,755.13 EUR (455,705,323.01 USD) under the share buy-back program. This corresponds to 0.36% of the total shares outstanding.
