

Mexico City, March 5, 2026 – Kimberly-Clark de México, S.A.B. de C.V. (KCM or the "Company") (BMV: KIMBER) announced that it has priced its Certificados Bursátiles of Ps. 10,000 million.

The Company issued Certificados Bursátiles (CEBURES) for the amount of Ps. 10,000 million through two Offerings, according to the following:

- Offering KIMBER 26 for Ps. 8,000 million at a fixed rate of 9.45% (Mbono+0.42%) with a legal term of 12 years with equal amortizations in years 10, 11 and 12.
- Offering KIMBER 26-2 for Ps. 2,000 million at a floating rate of TIIE de Fondeo + 37 basis points with a term of 2.6 years.

Settlement is scheduled for March 9, 2026, subject to customary closing conditions.

Both offerings received a credit rating of mxAAA from S&P Global Ratings S.A. de C.V. and of AAA(mex) by Fitch México S.A. de C.V.

The proceeds will be used for general corporate purposes within the ordinary course of the issuer's business.
