

Unusual movements presented today in the securities representing capital stock of Vista Oil & Gas, S.A.B. de C.V. with the ticker symbol "VISTA".

Mexico City, June 14, 2019 – Vista Oil & Gas, S.A.B. de C.V. ("Vista" or the "Company") (BMV: VISTA), the first oil and gas exploration and production company listed on the Mexican Stock Exchange, announced that, in connection with the unusual movements presented today in the securities identified with the ticker symbol "VISTA", the Company has no information regarding the causes of such movements, that they correspond to market conditions and that in terms of article 106 of the Securities Market Law (*Ley del Mercado de Valores*) and article 50, last but one paragraph, of the General Provisions Applicable to Securities Issuers and Other Securities Market Participants (the "<u>Regulations</u>") (*Disposiciones de Carácter General Aplicables a las Emisoras de Valores y a Otros Participantes del Mercado de Valores* o *Circular Única de Emisoras*), with the information known by the Company as of this moment, in connection with the above mentioned movements, the Company has no knowledge whether the members of the board of directors or any relevant executives had participated in such movements. The Company does not have a buyback fund as of this date.

This statement is made at the request of the Mexican Stock Exchange (*Bolsa Mexicana de Valores*), pursuant Article 106 of the Securities Market Law and Article 50, last but one paragraph, of the Regulations.
