

GENTERA informs S&P Global Ratings rating actions

Mexico City, March 5, 2019 – GENTERA S.A.B. de C.V. (BMV: GENTERA*) informs the actions taken by S&P Global ratings on **Banco Compartamos S.A. I.B.M.**, GENTERA's main subsidiary, after the change of perspective in the sovereign rating of Mexico to Negative from Stable on March 1st, 2019.

S&P Global Ratings took the following actions:

- Affirmed the global scale 'BBB/A-2' rating to Banco Compartamos.
- Affirmed the national scale 'mxAAA/mxA-1+' rating.
- Outlook: 'Negative'
- Affirmed the national scale 'mxAAA' issue-level rating on Banco Compartamos' senior unsecured debt.

S&P Global Ratings issued a press release today, which stated the following:

"...S&P Global Ratings took rating actions on different Mexican financial institutions following the sovereign outlook and after revising Mexico's BICRA economic risk trend to negative from stable. Our rating actions reflect various aspects about how the sovereign ratings and our BICRA affect our view of financial institutions we rate in the Mexico. Furthermore, our outlook revisions reflect the relative strengths or weaknesses of each financial institution's stand-alone credit profile (SACP)..."
